- From your previous schedule, it will appear everything is behind schedule now as I write
- The IG as at now is not fully informed about your Ambazonia "House of Representatives or Parliament", it's origin, activities, composition and mandate. More information to enlighten us at the interim government will be very helpful so that we can find a better way of working together in moving our revolution ahead
- What are the particular concerns about our revolution that led to the conceptualization of this venture from your side? Have other options for addressing such concerns been sorted out prior to choosing the current approach?
- What agenda is envisaged for each of the various planning phases prior to the conference in addition to the actual conference agenda?
- Given that the interim government already scheduled a similar meeting for February 2019 and also putting into consideration that our current aforementioned concerns at the Interim government would be addressed by your team, will there be a possibility to synchronize your proposals with our goals within our " All Ambazonian Stakeholders Consultative Conference (AASCC) of February 2019"?
- I'm very sure you all are aware and mindful of the various resolutions that emanated from our recent joint security council meeting, following the most unfortunate killing of our restoration forces in Guzang, Batibo. As a result of this and other unfortunate and painful incidents, we at the interim government have for the time being temporarily suspended all forms of collaboration with some nationalist platforms and their leaders.
